Here are my Treasurer updates that someone can present. If there are any questions please let me know. At the meeting if anything gets approved can you please let me know and I will add it to my approval spreadsheet.

Donation Account:

Current Balance: \$12, 977.12

Cheque has been written to the school but not yet deposited for \$1433.20 (\$1250 teacher conference meal and \$183.20 office furniture)

Once cheque is deposited then the balance will be \$11,543.92

Casino Account:

Current Balance: \$33, 249.56

Last Casino Advisor cheque was deposited of \$1154.80

Cheque was deposited by the school for \$5042.88 (previously approved invoices - math games, hearts and eyeballs, Library books and Shakespeare performance) Rachel paid insurance amount owing via etransfer of \$550

I looked into when we received our current casino funds and when they have to be fully spent. We have until August 2026 to use them. 36 months from the time of deposit. It would be good to use more by year end since we will be receiving our next casino funds by summer I would imagine. At the moment we have approved up to \$4000 for Grade 9 River Watch. Everything else that was previously approved

in the fall has been paid. We do need to discuss Drumheller Bussing for Grade 7. It was estimated at up to \$8700 but we haven't approved anything. Someone should bring that up at the April meeting.

I also went to the Music Parents Meeting and they are short some money for bussing. It was more expensive than they were originally hoping for. Anyways I believe someone is going to come to the April meeting with a potential request for funds. It was minimal and bussing can be approved with Casino funds of which we have quite a bit of. Just wanted to give you a heads up just in case.

Lastly I ended up getting our Vincent Massey Parent Council Association D&O Insurance via NFP Canada Corp (Lloyd's Underwriters is the Policy carrier). It was \$550 for the year. The Music Parents Association is debating whether insurance is even needed. They are using up their old funds fairly quickly and currently only raising around \$2000 per year so spending \$550 per year on insurance doesn't seem worth it. I did tell them they might want to check with AGLC to see if they need it anymore. They do host 50/50 raffles on occasion which is why they might want to check with AGLC. Anyways we approved up to \$1200 for both associations insurance at the last meeting but I decided to proceed with just our policy until I hear from the VMMPCA.

Consider how to spend the \$30,000 this year (David will ask the teachers for their budget items and what makes the most sense in a coordinated plan). Get ahead of the teachers' wish list for projects (ask them in June). David agreed that the end of year is best rather than September. The question will be "What are the types of teacher requests that reach the most learners?"

7. **Fundraiser Committee Report**: Think about how to spend the Casino money, have it spent by August 2026, or you can ask for longer if need be. David will look into the courtyard furniture logistics and plausibility in the future.

8. New Business:

A)Music Request:

Tomorrow is band camp (cost is \$2100) we pay for those that can't go. The teacher is \$440 over from what they motioned. Heather R. brought receipts and can provide evidence of spending. They are saving money by renting a yellow bus rather than a full blown coach, while music instruments are in a Uhaul. Council can choose which bills you'd like to cover. Discussion - we want to support projects for each grade % student is in band. Success of the Gr. 7 program builds capacity and diversity in the band program, so it is nice that the band is a priority from the council.

Motion by Chris L. is to cover cost for music program (receipts available) in the amount of \$850.50 for Grade 7 band camp transportation costs of bussing.

Last day of school is June 26th. Considering Friday the 20th OR afternoon/evening of 23rd are just two suggestions from David and Jen.
